In the framework of the international project SPIN, a series of seminars is organised for small and medium sized enterprises (SMEs) in Lithuania. The programme consists of four seminars and consultations provided to participating SMEs between the training seminars. Result of this programme will be threefold: (i) a number of eco-innovations developed in participating SMEs; (ii) personnel trained in the area of eco-innovation development in SMEs; and (iii) cleaner production principles integrated in the management systems of SMEs. The first introductory seminar was held on 8<sup>th</sup> April 2010 in Kaunas.

Second seminar is to be held on 14-15<sup>th</sup> October. This seminar will focus on methodology for development of innovations in SMEs and will be used to share information on new developments in the area of promoting and supporting innovation development and implementation as well as to exchange innovation development and implementation experience among SMEs. Participants will include SMEs, Ministry of Economy, Chamber of Commerce, Centre for Industrial Sustainable Development and the Institute of Environmental Engineering, Kaunas University of Technology. SPIN project partners from other countries are welcome to participate in the seminar.
